Please note that the Inquiry will be conducting hearings for several months. Witnesses can also attend virtually. If you are not able to attend on the Summons date, please email the Commission Administrator at [commissioner@nationalcitizensinquiry.ca](mailto:commissioner@nationalcitizensinquiry.ca) to arrange a time when you can attend. Please also note that the Commission has the discretion to schedule a virtual hearing for the purpose of accommodating a witness such as yourself who may not be able to attend any of the scheduled hearing dates.

The National Citizens Inquiry is a citizen-led and citizen-funded inquiry into Canada's response to Covid-19. Its Rules of Procedure and Terms of Reference are available at <https://nationalcitizensinquiry.ca/>.

The Inquiry is independent of government and operates without legal compulsion or coercion. A failure to comply with this Summons or with the Inquiry's Rules of Procedure cannot lead to civil or criminal liability, but it could result in the Commissioners making a finding of misconduct against you.

The Inquiry's Rules of Procedure require you to produce copies of all documents in your possession or under your control relevant to the subject-matter of the Inquiry within 10 days of receiving this summons. If you object to producing documents, the Inquiry's Rules of Procedure require you to deliver to the Commission Administrator at [commissioner@nationalcitizensinquiry.ca](mailto:commissioner@nationalcitizensinquiry.ca) within 10 days a written objection describing the nature and scope of your objection along with any appropriate supporting material, such as an affidavit or authorities.
