One significant change that happened today was the transition from the current level C tier response to a level A tier in Whitby and Pickering. I anticipate the other services switching as well and we will review regularly to determine if there is an impact to responses. A great message came out from your Peer Support team today and I encourage you to review that if you haven't had an opportunity to review. In light of the announcement regarding Hillsdale and COVID positive patients there, I would like to suggest to all that in the event you are responding to any LTC home you take the opportunity to wear a mask, gloves, and eye protection on all calls to LTC facilities. The gowns should only be required if you intend to perform an aerosolizing procedure however I am confident in staffs ability to decide the necessity of a gown. As we gather more information we will continue to share. Keep up the good work and stay safe.
