Dr Tess Lawrie is the Director of the Evidence-Based Medicine Consultancy Ltd and EbMCsquared CIC in Bath, UK. She is also the founder of the British Ivermectin Recommendation Development initiative and the co-founder of the World Council for Health. Tess is committed to helping to improve the quality of healthcare globally through rigorous research, as well as empowering people to take responsibility for their health.

Dr Lawrie completed her medical degree in Johannesburg, South Africa in 1990. Thereafter, she worked in the field of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at various teaching hospitals in South Africa. She obtained her MRCOG Part 1 in 1996 from the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (UK) and, in 1999, she obtained a PhD degree from the University of the Witwatersrand (SA). In 2009 she relocated to the UK and founded the Evidence-Based Medicine Consultancy Ltd, an independent medical research company in 2013.

Dr Lawrie's research experience includes conducting systematic reviews, designing randomised trials, writing scientific manuscripts, and developing clinical practice guidelines. To date, she has published in excess of 80 papers in peer-reviewed journals and is among the top 5% of Researchgate members. She currently also holds an Honorary Research Consultant position with the Cochrane Gynaecological,

Neuro-Oncology and Orphan Cancer Group based at the Royal United Hospital in Bath, UK.

In 2021, Dr Lawrie established the community interest company EbMCsquared CIC to address the public need for transparent and objective research related to repurposed medicines and integrative health care options, and improved public health. With EbMCsquared CIC, she founded the British Ivermectin Recommendation Development initiative and, more recently, has co-founded the World Council for Health, empowering people and communities towards better health for all.
