- Children are exposed to inappropriate and divisive material marketed to be positive and inclusive
- Materials include illustrated porn books exposing "touching feels good masturbation" and sex acts to children as young as 5
- Gender Dysphoria was officially created in 2013 and is now a \$3 trillion, and growing industry
- Schools may withhold medical and other critical information from parents, including gender identities

### TAKE ACTION!

- Know your child's teachers and the assignments given. Some encourage touching at a young age
- Find the many age inappropriate books on the task force website and check your child's library and classroom
- Parents be aware, most patients are predominantly girls. Puberty blockers, and surgery = \$\$\$
- Gender fluidity may confuse, causing name and pronoun changes or the seeking of puberty blockers
